Description:

Recognising the growing importance of logistics and supply chain management, the Logistics Institute is the only dedicated facility of its kind in the North of England.

The Institute will house a range of high-tech facilities including technology development labs, technology showcase units and business incubation units.

The University buildings Nidd and Esk were constructed around 1911, the buildings are

situated parallel to one another, joined by a single storey link.

Alan Wood & Partners were responsible for the Structural work involved in both the refurbishment of the existing 3 storey Nidd building and the complete demolition and rebuild of the Esk building. The buildings were then linked together with a fully glazed frameless glass wall.
