## Description:

The Building Surveying department of Alan Wood & Partners were appointed by the University to design and manage the refurbishment of the 1960's male and female toilets in Central Hall in a building used for concerts, conferences and examinations.

The brief was to strip out the old, outdated toilets shown in the small photograph and to

provide new facilities as shown above. As part of the design a new disabled toilet was provided by re-planning the space. The project involved overcoming major drainage problems and asbestos contamination.

The project was delivered within budget and on programme, in time for the annual meeting of the Bishops of the Church of England
