Description:

After a disastrous fire, Tryton Foods Ltd. had an urgent need for new production facilities. The project at Freightliner Road was therefore divided into two distinct phases, the first involving the very substantial conversion of an existing portal frame building to allow the re-starting of production as soon as possible.

This project, due in the main to the very serious time constraint, required very detailed planning and close co-operation with all elements of the design team, contractor and client. Phase 1 was completed on schedule to allow production to re-commence.

Phase 2 of the project involved the new-build of substantial new production facilities, storage including a cold store facility, offices and staff areas. The project once completed, again on time and to budget, represented a very substantial improvement in the pre-fire facilities for Tryton Foods Ltd.

Alan Wood & Partners were responsible for the whole of the structural and civil design of the project, including all superstructure design and piled foundations.
