Refurbishment of Market Hall

The new look Scarborough Market Hall and Vaults has been transformed to create a fresh and modern retail space for businesses, shoppers and the local community, which has successfully retained the charm and character of the traditional market in the impressive, Grade II listed historic building.

With a grant from the Coastal Communities Fund, administered by the Big Lottery Fund, the facility has had a complete makeover with brand new units installed on the Market Hall floor and the addition of a new mezzanine level above to create new shops, offices and a food court that gives customers stunning views of Scarborough Castle.
