Description:

The project involved the part demolition of a single storey building at the front of the school and a state of the art Sixth Form facility and new entrance to the school.

The new extension forms a glazed elevation to the school with new floors linked into the existing school and serviced by a new glass lift.

The main structure is a steel framed building with composite metal deck floors providing a minimal appearance within the building.

The foundations required piling due to a large build up of made ground and restricted site access that limited the use of mass fill foundations.
