Description:

Howsham Mill dates back to c1755 and is attributed to architect John Carr of York. Despite its great historical and architectural interest, years of vandalism and neglect have taken a heavy toll.

Alan Wood & Partners were commissioned by the Renewable Heritage Trust to restore the building to its original splendour, for use as an educational resource centre. We are

providing Project Management, Structural and Civil Engineering services. Key elements include replacing the collapsed pyramid roof structure and mezzanine floor with new oak framing.

The scheme has recently been successful in obtaining Heritage Lottery funding and we are now working towards tender documentation, with a construction period anticipated to commence in Spring 2012.
