Description:

Hull City Council have developed the once derelict Humber and Railway Docks into a fully equipped and operating marina adjacent to the City Centre.

Alan Wood & Partners were appointed as Consulting Engineers by the Council for the project and were responsible for all Civil and Structural elements from the initial feasibility through to completion.

Approximately 300 berths have been provided in the complete marina and the docks are surrounded by new developments giving the area character and appeal.

Alan Wood & Partners were responsible for the design, drafting, contract compilation and supervision of numerous infrastructure elements including the refurbishment of the new lock with the sector lock gates, a new dock wall, stabilisation of existing walls, an impounding scheme, a boat hoist, boat yard with repair facilities, dredging, berthing pontoons with services and paving of open areas.

The project is a concentrated example of a broad spectrum of work successfully carried out by Alan Wood & Partners ranging from the large marine contracts for the lock through to the structural engineering required for the refurbishment of the existing buildings.
