Description:

Isis in Hyde Park is a major new public work by British sculptor Simon Gudgeon. The iconic piece was commissioned to help raise funds for a new education centre for children and a new home for the Royal Parks Foundation.

Alan Wood & Partners were commissioned to assist the Landscape Agency with the

foundation design and base details for the granite plinth.

We also produced the method statement for installation of the 690kg bronze statue. This was complicated by the need to resin fix 1m long holding down bolts through the plinth into the concrete base below.
